Share Why You Care:

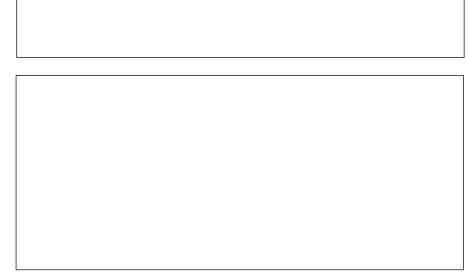
- Introduce yourself and your connection to the community of project.
- Describe how the project will impact you as directly as possible.
 - □ Be clear and concise.
 - □ Use respectful language.
 - Focus on your strongest point first.

Name The Problem:

- Describe how it will impact the community or change the nature of the community.
- □ Are there *Environmental Justice* Concerns?

Provide Solutions.

- □ Is the project using the *Best Technology*?
- □ Is another site better suited for the permit activity?
- How does the No Build Alternative compare to the proposal?
- □ Are there ways to lesson harm or increase transparency?
- Use examples from past projects or similar projects in other areas.
- Make a concrete ask.
